- Title:** The Department of the Association Restructuring Act of 2007.
- Section 1:** This Act shall be known and may be cited as The Department of the Association Restructuring Act of 2007.
- Section 2:** PURPOSE. The Department of the Association exists to advocate for students. Currently it is structured according to functions (e.g. "Office of Resolution Advocacy," "Student Rights Office," "Council of Student Delegates"). This act restructures the Association by adding Exterior City, State and Federal functions, to allow advocacy for UOSA as whole at the campus, city, state and federal level.
- Section 3:** Repeal. UOSACA 3.6.26 Director shall be and are hereby repealed.
- Section 4:** NEW LAW: A new section of law to be codified in the UOSACA as Title III, Chapter \_\_ and renumbered accordingly:

DIRECTOR OF THE ASSOCIATION INTERIOR CAMPUS RELATIONS.

There shall be a Director of the Association Interior Campus Relations, responsible for overseeing and coordinating the Office of Resolution Advocacy, Student Rights Office, and Council of Student Delegates.

DIRECTOR OF THE ASSOCIATION EXTERIOR CAMPUS RELATIONS.

There shall be a Director of the Association Exterior Campus Relations, responsible for overseeing and coordinating the Office of City and State Legislative Relations and Research and the Office of Federal Relations and Research.

OFFICE OF CITY AND STATE LEGISLATIVE RELATIONS AND RESEARCH.

- A. PURPOSE. The Office shall be a source of information for the membership of UOSA regarding local, city and state government issues affecting students, by researching, educating and mobilizing students.
- B. COORDINATOR. The Coordinator shall be responsible for managing and ensuring the execution of the purpose of the office.
- C. OFFICE MEMBERS. Office members shall be known as Legislative Aides. Office members shall be selected on the basis of advocacy skill and commitment to the office purpose.

OFFICE OF FEDERAL RELATIONS AND RESEARCH.

- A. PURPOSE. The Office shall be a source of information for the membership of UOSA regarding federal government issues

affecting students, by researching, educating and mobilizing students.

- B. COORDINATOR. The Coordinator shall be responsible for managing and ensuring the execution of the purpose of the office.
- C. OFFICE MEMBERS. Office members shall be known as Legislative Aides. Office members shall be selected on the basis of advocacy skill and commitment to the office purpose.

**Section 2:** This Act shall be hereby enacted upon passage in accordance with the UOSA Constitution.
