AS INTRODUCED

An act relating to finance; amending the UOSACA Title 12, Chapter 4, Section 23 which concerns the administrative districts of the UOSA; establishing the Multicultural Greek Council as an administrative district of UOSA; providing the benefits inherent with that classification; amending the UOSACA Title 12, Chapter 5, Section 33, which concerns positions receiving a stipend; establishing the Multicultural Greek Council as a position receiving a stipend; providing codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA STUDENT ASSOCIATION:

**Section 1:** AMENDATORY: Title 12, Chapter 4, Section 23 (a) of the UOSACA is hereby amended as follows:

**23. Administrative Districts of the UOSA**

**a. Categories**

Organizations must fit into one of these three categories to be considered an Administrative Division of UOSA: Government: Organizations that collectively serve as student government for the entire student body without significant duplication. Residential: Organizations that collectively represent every student through their residences without significant duplication. Funding is provided for Housing Center Student Association, ~~Commuter Student Association~~, Interfraternity Council, National Pan-Hellenic Council, Panhellenic Council, Multicultural Greek Council, and Latino Greek Council. No additional funding will be distributed to separate entities (houses/floors/chapters) of these organizations. Campus Activities: Organizations that represent and serve every student through campus wide activities aimed at improving student life on campus without significant duplication. An organization that falls under the Campus Activities category may not represent a particular Sec. of the student body, rather it must represent the entire student body. All programming sponsored by that organization shall have discretion in allocating these funds. *The Budget Procedures Act of 1997, as amended; originally Congressional Bill No. 560702 and Senate Bill No. GS97-18, Sec. 4(A).*

## **b. Regulations**

Administrative organizations are subject to these UOSA Regulations:

i. Administrative organizations must hold a UOSA sanctioned election for their chief officer, unless otherwise specified in the UOSACA. For the purpose of this election, each organization must register all of its members with the UOSA to vote, with the exception of Campus Activities Council Chair, who shall be elected in a campus wide election by the entire student body.

ii. Administrative organizations must be entirely comprised of student members.

**Section 2:** AMENDATORY: Title 12, Chapter 5, Section 33 of the UOSACA is hereby amended as follows (strikethrough indicating deletions and underline indicating additions):

### **Section**

#### **33. Positions Receiving a Salary/Stipend**

The following positions shall receive a salary/stipend:

Associate of General Counsels: \$11.00 x 50 hours/week x 34 weeks

Campus Activities Council Chair: \$325/month Fall & Spring, \$250/month Summer

Chair of Congress: \$325/month Fall and Spring, \$250/month, Summer

Chair of Senate: \$325/month Fall and Spring, \$250/month, Summer

~~Commuter Student Association President: \$250/month Fall and Spring,~~

\$175/month Summer

Election Board Members: 5 individuals per election, \$40 x 5 persons x 2 general elections

Election Chair: \$500/Spring General Election, \$200/Fall General Election

Election Poll Operators: 20 individuals per election, \$20 x 20 persons x 2 general elections

General Counsel: \$12.00 x 25 hours/week x 48 weeks

Housing Center Student Association President: \$250/month/Fall and Spring, \$175/month/Summer

Interfraternity Council President: \$250/month/Fall and Spring

Latino Greek Council: \$250/month/Fall and Spring

Multicultural Greek Council: \$250/month/Fall and Spring

National Pan-Hellenic Council President: \$250/month/Fall and Spring

Panhellenic Council President: \$250/month/Fall and Spring

UOSA Staff Assistant II: \$12.00/hour x 2080 Hours

UOSA Staff Assistant III: \$16.00/hour x 2080 Hours

Secretary of Congress: \$175/month/Fall and Spring

Secretary of Senate: \$175/month/Fall and Spring

Student Bar Association President: \$250/month/ Fall and Spring

UOSA President: \$425/month/Fall and Spring, \$350/month Summer

UOSA Vice President: \$325/month/Fall and Spring, \$250/month Summer  
Vice Chair of Congress: \$225/month/Fall and Spring  
Vice Chair of Senate: \$225/month/Fall and Spring  
Chief of Staff: [minimum wage] x 10 hours/week Fall and Spring  
Director of the Student Organization Resource Office: [minimum wage] x 10 hours/week Fall and Spring

Any position not enumerated above shall not receive a salary/stipend. *Stipends and Salaries Act of 2003, as amended; originally Congressional Bill No. 680704 and Senate Bill No. GF02-40, Secs 3 through 10 and 13.*

**a. Traffic Court Justices**

The Traffic Court Justices are appointed at minimum wage, but not funded by UOSA; the positions are reimbursed through the Parking and Transit Office. *Stipends and Salaries Act of 2003; Congressional Bill No. 680704 and Senate Bill No. GF02-40, Sec. 6.*

**Section 3:** This act shall be effective when passed and signed in accordance with the UOSA Constitution.
