AS INTRODUCED

An act establishing polling sites for the 2008 UOSA Fall
General Election.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA STUDENT ASSOCIATION:

- Section 1:** This act shall be known and may be cited as the 2008 UOSA Fall General Election Act.
- Section 2:** PURPOSE: The purpose of this Act is to establish polling sites for the 2008 UOSA Spring General Election in accordance with Title VII, Chapter 2, Section 13 of the UOSA Code.
- Section 3:** The Legislative Branch hereby establishes the following physical polling sites – subject to approval by the appropriate University authorities:
- Bizzell Library
Dale Hall
Oklahoma Memorial Union
University Bus Stop
University Housing
- Section 4:** The Legislative Branch also establishes the official election website administered by Information Technology as a “polling site”.
- Section 5:** Physical polling sites shall be open 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on the days of the election. The voting system on the website will be activated at 8:00 a.m. on Tuesday, November 11, 2008 and it will remain running throughout the night and into the next day until 9:00 p.m. on Wednesday, November 12, 2008.
- Section 6:** The Election Chair is also authorized to establish a procedure to accept provisional paper ballots in the UOSA Office if any students have difficulties casting their votes.
- Section 7:** This act shall be effective when passed and signed in accordance with the UOSA Constitution.
