AS INTRODUCED

An act amending Title XII, Chapter 4, Section 29.c.i of the UOSACA; providing for short title; stating purpose; increasing access to UOSA funding; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA STUDENT ASSOCIATION:

- Section 1:** This act shall be known and may be cited as the “Student Organization Appropriation Deregulation Stimulus” Act of 2009.
- Section 2:** PURPOSE. The purpose of this act is to amend the UOSACA to allow more organizations the opportunity to apply for and utilize funding opportunities in order to pursue the aims and goals of their organization, while they wait the one year to apply for Primary funding.
- Section 3:** AMENDATORY. Title XII, Chapter 4, Section 29.c.i is hereby amended to read as follows:
- i. Registration: Only those registered student organizations that are located on the Norman campus will be funded. Any student organization that is affiliated with the University of Oklahoma but not located on the Norman campus will not receive funding through this campus. Each organization must have been registered with the Office of Student Affairs, or the equivalent thereof, by the eighth week of spring classes of the school year prior to the Emergency Allocations process, and must re-register by the fourth week of classes of the Fall semester in accordance with the Student Code, Title 10, Sec. 4.5.
- Section 4:** This act shall become effective when passed in accordance with the UOSA Constitution.
