**AS INTRODUCED-CONFERENCE REPORT**

AN ACT ADVISING AND CONSENTING TO THE ALLOCATIONS REGARDING THE CONOCO STUDENT LEADERSHIP WING AND UNION STORAGE FACILITIES; ESTABLISHING PERMANENT OFFICE SPACES FOR CERTAIN STUDENT ORGANIZATIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA STUDENT ASSOCIATION:

**Section 1:** The purpose of this act is inherent in the title.

**Section 3:** Organizations will be notified of these allocations and will be expected to attend an informational meeting on April 17, 2009 in order to review expectations, inventories, and office moving times. **Section 4:** Outgoing and incoming organizations are to communicate and facilitate transfer of office no later than Monday, May 4, 2009 at 12:00 am. If an organizations fails to do this, future use of offices, cubicles, and storage facilities may be restricted.

**Section 5:** NEW LAW. A new section of law to be codified in the UOSACA as Chapter 3, Section 9, Paragraph A of Title 10 unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
