Title: AN ACT ESTABLISHING POLLING LOCATIONS FOR THE FALL 2006 UOSA GENERAL ELECTION

Section 1: This act shall be known and may be cited as AN ACT ESTABLISHING POLLING LOCATIONS FOR THE FALL 2006 UOSA GENERAL ELECTION.

Section 2: The purpose of this act is inherent in the title.

Section 3: Polls shall be set up in the following locations for the Fall 2006 UOSA General Election:

Oklahoma Memorial Union - first floor near food court
Dale Hall – outside the front entrance on the South Oval
Bizzell Statue – south of the Bizzell Statue on the South Oval

Section 4: In the case of a run-off election, polls shall be set up in the following location:

Oklahoma Memorial Union – first floor near food court

Section 5: As elections are to be held online, <http://elections.ou.edu> shall be considered an official poll location; further, all campus computer labs shall be considered polling locations.

Section 6: Polls shall be multipurpose, but the number of computers available at each poll other than those described in Section 5 shall be established by a ruling of the Election Chair at least three days prior to the election.

Section 7: This act shall become effective when passed in accordance with the UOSA Constitution.




