AS INTRODUCED

A joint resolution consenting to taking measures to begin investigations of bringing the USA Today Collegiate Readership Program to the University of Oklahoma.

WHEREAS The Collegiate Readership Program a multi-faceted campus initiative that provides up to four recognized daily newspapers on campus each day of the semester for students' use.

WHEREAS USA Today made a presentation to the Undergraduate Student Congress on November 18, 2008 about the Collegiate Readership Program; and,

WHEREAS Reaction to the prospect of the Collegiate Readership Program coming to the University of Oklahoma has been very positive; and,

WHEREAS UOSA leaders are wanting to be as transparent as possible in working to present a new proposal to the student body; and,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA STUDENT ASSOCIATION:

SECTION 1. UOSA approves the UOSA executive committee to proceed with measures exploring the opportunity to bring the Collegiate Readership Program to the University of Oklahoma.

SECTION 2. UOSA recommends any referendum on this issue be passed through the UOSA Legislature rather than through the signature option.
